IMPORTANT NOTICE ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING BEGINS NOVEMBER 1.

Effective for 24 hours beginning at 5 PM. "PARK FOR TOMORROW"

Example: on December 1^{St,} on or after 5PM Park your vehicle on the Even Side of the Street. ALL STREETS in the Village will have

24-hour alternate parking. Except the following:

Miller St. (One Way) - Parking on S. West Side Only. <u>Note: No parking on Miller St. - Midnight to 7AM</u> No Parking allowed any time on these listed roads: Church St. Old State Road - Chenango to Rt.7. <u>Beacon St. - between Chenango and Ki</u>rkwood Ave.

If a vehicle is parked illegally & poses an immediate problem, it will be towed at the owner's expense (plus storage costs) to expedite safe snow removal with reasonable consideration by the Police Department.

VILLAGE FRONT OFFICE HOURS ARE 9AM TO 3PM TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, AND THURSDAY. If you need assistance while the office is closed, please call the Village Business number at 607-771-8233, if urgent Police at 607-722-1255.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: This past year the Fire Department received grants totaling \$86,251.00 to replace outdated self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA's). Three new AED's (automatic external defibrillators) and brush fire equipment. Congratulations to Fire Chief Matt Griswold and the members for their hard work to make this happen.

TREE TRIMMING: It is the homeowner's responsibility to trim the trees on their property to allow for a min. of 7 feet of clearance over the sidewalk and street.

GARBAGE, RECYCLING & LAWN DEBRIS

<u>CONTAINERS</u> and assorted waste may be placed <u>in the areas between the sidewalk and</u> <u>curb AFTER 2PM the day prior to the day of</u> <u>each pickup. Containers must be removed no</u> <u>later than 8PM the evening of that pickup.</u> If you have more than your normal waste

In your have more than your normal waste container to be collected, you must notify your waste collector in advance of collection that day that you have excessive items to be collected. Failure to remove refuse will result in the Village or its contractor collecting this debris, and the property owner will be charged for the removal. Typical charge is approx. \$50.00.

RE: STORAGE OF RECYCLING, GARBAGE, DEBRIS & YARD WASTE CONTAINERS: - ALL CONTAINERS SHALL BE STORED BEHIND THE BUILDING OUT OF VIEW FROM THE STREET OR ROADWAY. IN NO EVENT MAY CONTAINERS BE STORED IN THE FRONT YARD OR THE FRONT PORCH OF BUILDINGS. In the event these containers or other

related items cannot be stored out of view from the street the property owner shall screen such areas of storage by opaque fencing and or plantings.

WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS:

SNOW & ICE LEFT ON SIDEWALKS: The **Village or contractors may clear sidewalks of snow and ice if they are not cleared by the owner within twenty-four (24) hours after a snowfall.** The cost of this removal & fee will be assessed against the owner of the property. We will attempt to notify the owner and be reasonable with this enforcement as adverse weather conditions direct. The minimum charge is \$75 plus additional labor and melting materials costs. Please be considerate and keep your sidewalks clear and safe.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Please help yourself, your neighbors and your Fire Department and keep our Hydrants clear of snow.

DISCHARGING / SHOVELING SNOW INTO THE STREET IS ILLEGAL. The Police and Code Enforcement will enforce this law. ANGEL OF HOPE MONUMENT: The monument in the Community Park will begin to add Memorial Bricks during the summer. The site is being improved and expanded. Memorial Bricks as well as monetary donations are being accepted. The deadline for a Memorial Brick order for the first installment is 1/1/25. Flyers are at the Village Hall. HELP YOUR POLICE DEPARTMENT HELP YOU.

PLEASE CALL THE POLICE IF YOU SEE OR HEAR ANY SUSPICIOUS OR UNUSUAL ACTIVITY or NOISES. No call is too minor, and you are not

required to provide your name when reporting.

You can report anything anonymously.

<u>THE POLICE DEPARTMENT</u>: wants to bring to your attention the following information and advice:

- UNLOCKED VEHICLES & HOMES ARE BEING ENTERED. REMEMBER; LOCK YOUR VEHICLES AND YOUR DOORS.
- CLOSE YOUR GARAGE DOORS WHEN NO ONE IS HOME.
- AVOID LEAVING BICYCLES AND VALUABLES OUTSIDE AT NIGHT.

<u>NOTE</u>: Evening, weekend & some day calls to the Police may be received by a County Dispatcher. If you have a problem (e.g., water or sewer) or desire to talk to an officer, just state your problem and ask the dispatcher to have a Port Dickinson Police Officer visit you or phone you and they will address your situation.

HOUSE NUMBERS: Numbers must be posted at the front entrance in a manner as to be legible and distinguishable from the street. This is NYS, County and Village Law. **Please help the Emergency Responders find your home.**

BARKING DOGS: If you have a problem with a barking dog, call the Police 607-722-1255 (anonymously if you like) if the Police or Code Officer witness the barking for 15 minutes (inside or out) a summons will be issued, and the Dog Control Officer will be notified for possible further action.
