### GOOD NEWS: THERE WILL BE NO INCREASE IN THE VILLAGE TAX RATE.

For the 3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row no increase, actually there will be minor decrease.

Planned improvements will be replacing the 4-inch Rochelle Rd. and Kirkwood Ave (dead end) water main with a 6-inch main and complete repaving. This main is inadequate and is also the alternate supply to the lower village as it feeds that area via the Phelps St. water main. We will try to add more playground equipment if those items are available.

HELP YOUR POLICE DEPARTMENT HELP YOU.

### PLEASE CALL THE POLICE IF YOU SEE OR HEAR ANY SUSPICIOUS OR UNUSUAL ACTIVITY.

No call is too small, and you are not required to provide your name when reporting.

POLICE DEPARMENT: Will be vigorously enforcing the State & Village Laws regarding illegal loud vehicles. The Police are now operating a Decibel Meter and will be enforcing the Decibel Limit of 60 DBA during the day and 50 at night in residential areas.

- UNLOCKED VEHICLES ARE BEING ENTERED. LOCK YOUR VEHICLE & YOUR HOME.
- <u>CLOSE YOUR GARAGE DOORS</u> when no one is at home as you are inviting theft.
- DO NOT LEAVE BICYCLES AND OTHER VALUABLE ITEMS OUTSIDE AT NIGHT.

**NOTE**: If you have a problem such as sewer or water when the Village Office is closed, please call the PD Police 607-722-1225, state your problem to the dispatcher and a Port Dickinson Officer will either visit you, meet you or phone to resolve your situation.

### **FIRES & OPEN BURNING:**

The burning of garbage, refuse and rubbish in any manner is prohibited in the Village. Open burning for outdoor cooking is prohibited in or on multiple-dwelling structures. <a href="NYS Open Burn Ban is">NYS Open Burn Ban is</a> March 15 to May 15.

### YARD WASTE PICKUP BEGINS TUESDAY APRIL 2

Cut grass will be collected on Tuesdays in April and May but grass collection ends May 27.

Remaining lawn debris will be collected.
(For information on grass composting contact Broome County Cooperative Extension on Front St.)

ALL DEBRIS MUST BE IN SOLID CONTAINERS.
Max. 40lbs. No overweight containers. NO PLASTIC
BAGS. BRANCHES MUST BE TIED IN 4 FT.
LENGTHS or IN CONTAINERS. Place containers
between the sidewalk and the curb after 2PM on day
prior to collection.

Please note due to the Holidays 5/28 pickup will be 5/29, and 9/3 will be 9/4.

IT IS ILLEGAL TO DISCHARGE GRASS, LAWN DEBRIS OR SNOW INTO THE STREET.

**TREE TRIMMING:** It is the homeowner's responsibility to trim trees on their property to allow for a min. of 7 feet of clearance over the sidewalk & street.

WATER SYSTEM: Our Public Works Dept. Will be flushing the entire water system during the week of 5/13 to 5/17, Midnight to 5AM, weather permitting. You may experience water discoloration. We will post signs on the streets and have a notice on the Village Website

Wood Burners, and \*Handicap Ramps.

TO AVOID DELAYS, LEGAL ACTION & ADDED
COSTS. Please allow time for the Inspector to return
your call. You can pick up permit applications at the
Village Hall.
